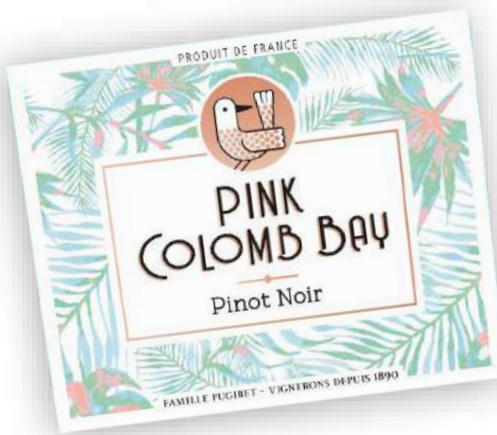

TASTING NOTES

Pale color with elegant reflections, atypical nose of fresh red fruits, discreet scent of garrigue.

Greedy and silky on the palate, underlined by aromas of citrus fruits, mineral finish.



SUGGESTIONS

Drink young and chilled (10°) to fully appreciate its fragrance and organoleptic qualities.

Ideal accompanied by cold meats and tapas as an aperitif with friends, but also at the table around grilled meats, Mediterranean or Asian dishes.

- In order to create this top-of-the-range rosé wine, we have chosen to select an exceptional grape variety: Pinot Noir. We harvest small airy bunches from the most qualitative clones, such as 114, 115 or 777. We thus gain in concentration to obtain more elaborate juices for vinification.
- In order to have a Rosé rich in aromas, we use techniques that have proven their worth on whites: the grapes from the oldest vines are bled and those from the youngest pressed. After settling, the musts ferment at low temperature and are then aged on the lees until bottling.
